

Welcome to the Cottages!

We are excited to be able to welcome you here again. As we continue to deal with the COVID-19 Pandemic, additional precautions are required to keep our residents and their guests safe from possible infection. We understand that these precautions can seem burdensome, but please know that we are following best—practice procedures to avoid infection.

As you visit, please keep the following in mind:

- All visitors must present a negative COVID-19 Test that was taken within 24 hours of visit.
 Test card must be dated and initialed.
- We strongly encourage all visitors to be fully vaccinated and have had a booster vaccination prior to visiting. Please let us know if you have any questions regarding the vaccination.
- Please sanitize your hands before entering and after leaving the visitation area.
- Please wear a mask at all times while on the grounds of our facility. A mask will be provided to you. ****Cloth masks are prohibited.
- All visits will take place in the resident's room with the door open (for supervision purposes).
 Visitors must be at least two years of age or older.
- Please maintain social distancing and wearing a mask-unfortunately physical contact must be avoided unless your loved one has both been fully vaccinated (2 weeks after the 2nd vaccine of Pfizer or Moderna, and 2 weeks after receiving the Johnson & Johnson vaccine).
- Please adhere to all instructions provided by the Cottages staff.
- If your loved one needs assistance, please alert one of our staff and they will assist.
- Please do not come to the facility to attend a visit if you are exhibiting any signs or symptoms, fever or if you have been recently in contact with an individual with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19.
- Please be respectful of, and avoid contact with other residents and visitors.
- Please do not hand food items to your loved ones. Please give the food items to staff so we can ensure that all diet restrictions and/or consistencies are followed.
- Visiting Hours: Monday-Friday 8am-4pm- please get screened and get a pass at our administrative offices located at cottage 5441. If you visit outside of these hours, please go to the cottage in which your loved one resides to be screened. Please be advised that you might experience a longer waiting time due to staff assisting residents, which is our priority.
- Additional information: Updates surrounding visitation will continue to be communicated via family email.

Visitors will be required to leave at any time, if they are unwilling or unable to comply with visitation guidelines or direction from staff. If there is continued non-compliance, visitation will be suspended indefinitely.
